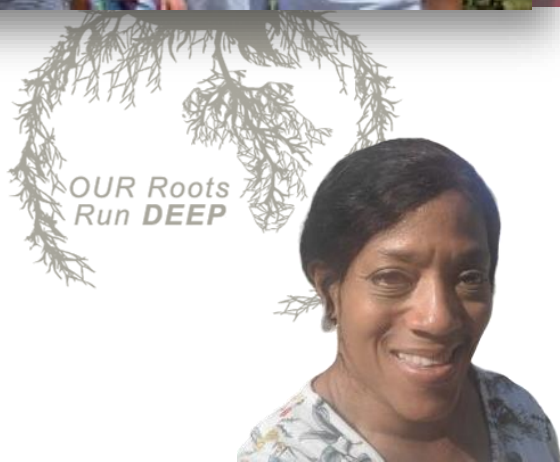

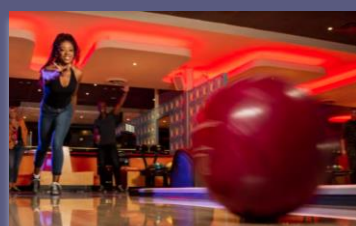
Saturday — Cash-Neill Family Picnic
